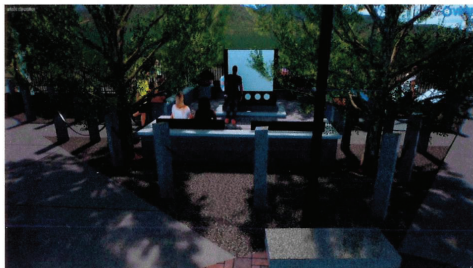
Some of our past accomplishments include:

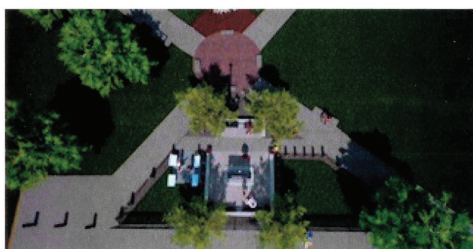
